Ten Marks of Legalism

(Matthew 23)

1. Laying religious burdens on others without praying for them (v4)
2. Doing religious works to be seen by others (v5)
3. Loving the honor of men (v6-12)
4. Refusing to be the servant (v11-12)
5. Preventing others from entering a New Covenant life (v13)

Ten Marks of Legalism

(Matthew 23)

6. Taking advantage of the needy (v14)
7. Evangelizing to build their own name, not to lead others into the New Covenant life (v15)
8. Being lovers of money (v16-22)
9. Focusing on minute points of the Law, while neglecting justice, mercy, and faithfulness (v23-24)
10. Focusing on outward conformity while neglecting inward spirituality (v25-28)
