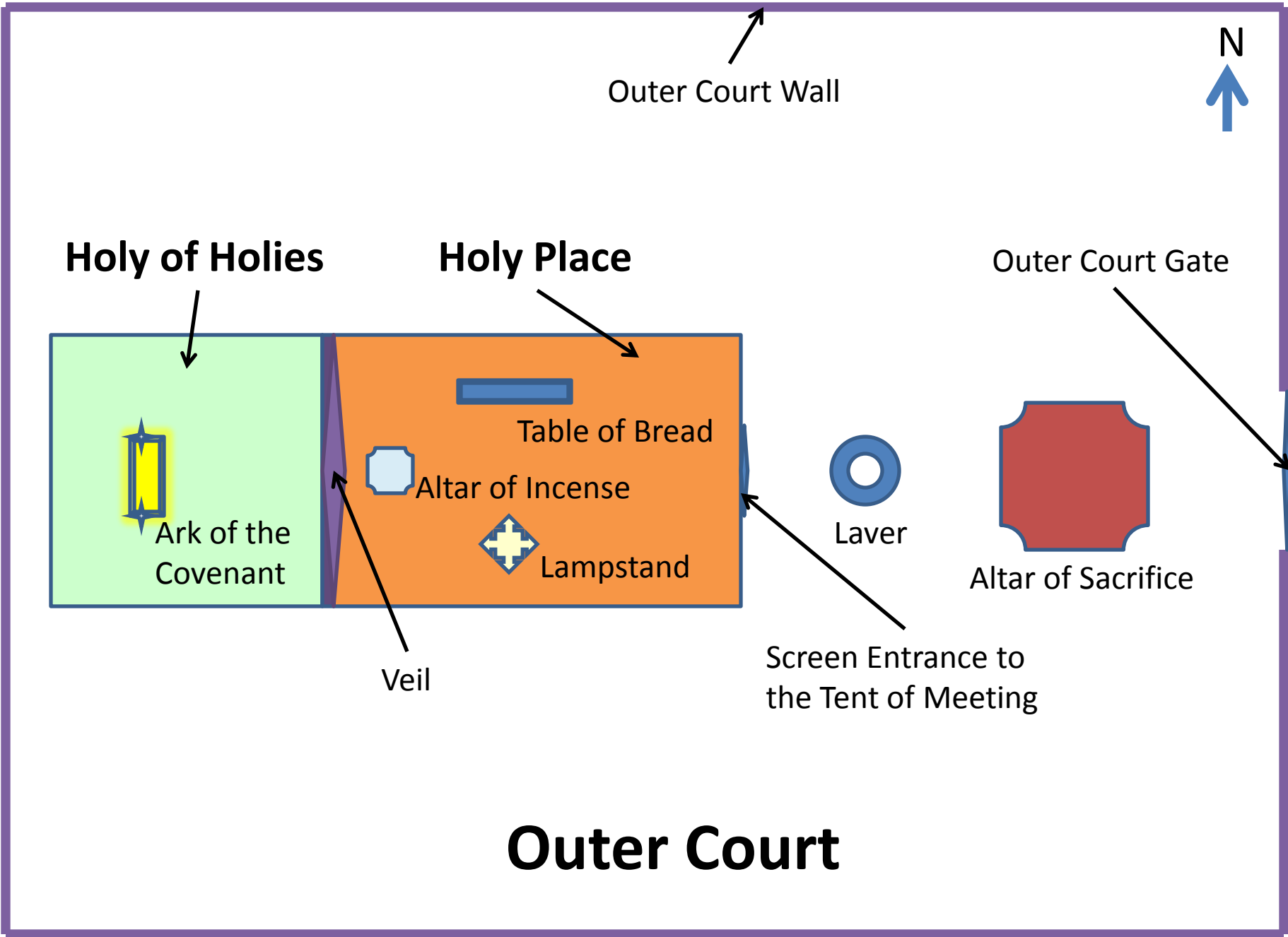

11. Laver



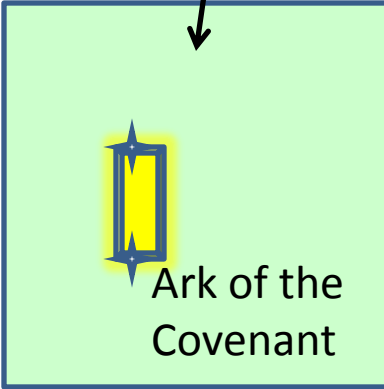

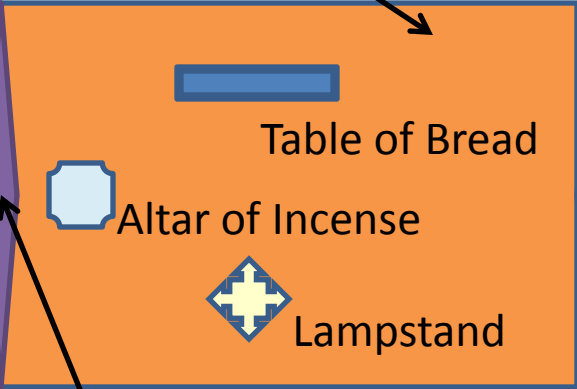

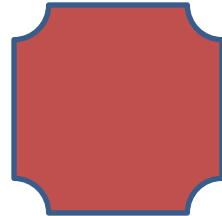

The New Covenant Tabernacle

- The Tent of Meeting (Holy Place): **individual members interwoven**
- The Ark of the Covenant:
 - The Mercy Seat: **the wrapping around God's glory**
 - The Cherubim: **guards to Tree of Life (Divine Nature)**
 - The Golden Jar with Manna: **never grew stale in God's presence**
 - Aaron's Rod which Budded: **God's approval over His delegated authority**
 - The Tablets of the Covenant: **God's Law always upheld in His presence**
- Entrance to the Most Holy Place: **the division between soul and spirit**
- The Table of the Bread: **every word that proceeds from the mouth of God**
- The Lampstand: **a Church of individual lamps united with each other**
- The Altar of Incense: **prayers ascending to heaven**
- Entrance to the Tent: **distinction between those sanctified and not**
- The Altar of Sacrifice: **the cross of Calvary**
- The Laver: **washing by the Word of God**
- The Outer Court: **separation from the world**
- Entrance to the Outer Court: **only one way to God – through Christ**
