

Burnt Offerings

- Reference: **Leviticus 1:1-17; 6:8-13; 8:18-21; 16:23,24**
- Purpose: To please God by worshipping Him
- Object:
 - Option #1: Bull without defect
 - Option #2: Male sheep/goat without defect
 - Option #3: Dove/Pigeon
- Method:
 - Lay hands on head of object and slay it
 - Sprinkle blood on the altar (fire always going)
 - Skin it and cut it into individual pieces
 - Wash away the inner organs and legs
 - Burn all night until morning
- New Testament (Romans 12:1-2): our bodies living

Grain Offerings

- Reference: **Leviticus 2:1-16; 6:14-23**
- Purpose: Thanksgiving to God as Provider of all good things
- Object:
 - Option #1: Fine wheat flour, olive oil and frankincense seasoned with salt
 - Option #2: Bread without yeast or honey baked in loaves or wafers, or fried in flat wafers
 - Option #3: Roasted fresh heads of grain, grits of new growth, olive oil and frankincense
- Method:
 - Burn on altar
- New Testament (Hebrews 13:15; Ephesians 5: 4,18-20; Colossians 3:16-17,4:2; I Thess. 5:18; I Timothy 2:1): prayer

Peace/Fellowship Offerings

- Reference: **Leviticus 3:1-17; 7:11-18,19-36; 19:5-8**
- Purpose: Thanksgiving, fulfillment of a vow, or freewill (all voluntary)
- Object:
 - Option #1: Male/Female bull/cow/sheep/goat without defect
 - Option #2: Various breads made without yeast
- Method:
 - Lay hands on head of object and slay it
 - Burn fat of the inner organs, the two kidneys and the liver lobe
 - Eaten on the day it was sacrificed, or the day after, but not on the third day (19:5-8)
- New Testament (Ephesians 2:13-18; Colossians 1:20; Romans 5:1): justification through Jesus Christ

Sin Offerings

- Reference: **Leviticus 4:1-12,13-5:13; 6:24-30; 8:14-17; 16:3-22**
- Purpose: Forgiveness for specific, known, unintentional sins; or to be cleansed from uncleanness
- Object:
 - Whole nation or the High Priest : young bull
 - Tribal Leader: male goat
 - Ordinary person: female goat/lamb
 - Poor: 2 doves/pigeons
 - Very poor: 2 pounds of fine flour
- Method:
 - Lay hands on head of object and slay it
 - Priest dip finger in blood and sprinkle seven times in front of veil and put on horns of altar of incense
 - Burn fat, 2 kidneys and liver lobe and then priests eat it
 - Burn skin, flesh, head, legs and inner organs outside the camp
- New Testament (Isa.53:5, Heb.9:11-14,10:10; I Pet.1:13-21): blood of Jesus

Guilt Offerings

- Reference: **Leviticus 5:14-6:7; 7:1-6**
- Purpose: For violating holy things; or for robbing or cheating someone
- Object:
 - Ram without defect
 - Price of the ram in addition to paying back what was stolen plus 20 percent
- Method:
 - Slay the object
 - Sprinkle blood around on altar
 - Burn fat, 2 kidneys, liver lobe and then priests eat it
- New Testament (I Corinthians 11:27; James 2:9-11): the holy - sin; Breaking of Bread; Lord's Name; our bodies
