Verse	The Wicked Fool	The Righteous Wise
6	tells <u>lies</u> to get treasure, which is <u>fleeting</u> , results in <u>death</u>	
7	<u>dragged</u> away by own violence; <u>refuse</u> to obey	
8	<u>crooked</u> ways	<u>pure, upright</u> conduct
9	builds a <u>wide</u> house, but <u>quarrels</u> in it	
10	begins with desiring in <u>soul</u> ; takes no thought for <u>others</u>	
11	others learn from his <u>mistakes</u>	learns from <u>teaching</u>
12		learns by considering the <u>wicked's end</u>
13	<u>unanswered prayers</u> because shut ears to cries of <u>others</u>	
14		returns evil with <u>good deeds</u>
15	are in <u>terror</u> at execution of justice	loves execution of <u>justice</u>
16	<u>wander</u> from way of understanding, into <u>death</u>	
17	become poor by loving <u>pleasure</u> (wine and oil)	
18	“What a bad person plots against the good, <u>boomerangs</u> ; the plotter gets it in the end.”	
19	house is like a <u>desert</u> because of quarreling	
20	<u>spends</u> everything	<u>stores</u> treasure
21		finds life, righteous, honor by <u>pursuing</u>
22		brings down strongholds of <u>human might</u>
23		guards his soul by guarding what he says
24	pride, haughtiness, scoffing, insolence	
25-26	killed by his own constant craving, because of <u>laziness</u>	thinks of giving to <u>others</u>
27	<u>religious</u> ; two-fold abomination: <u>deed</u> and <u>motive</u>	
28	lying <u>dies</u>	truth <u>abides</u>
29	looks scary, but is <u>faking</u> it	is <u>sure</u> of his steps
30-31	has a form of wisdom, understanding, counsel which is <u>against God</u>	does his best, but <u>trusts God</u>
