What are signs of a person who has insecurities?

- Good for us has individuals and as a church to examine these insecurities so that we can be cleansed
 - Some gets commended/appreciated and we don't receive the same (Gen 4:4, 5)
 - Having a sense of jealousy where we cannot rejoice with those who rejoice and are not weeping with those who are weep (Rom 12:15)
 - Constant sense of punishment for something that I have done wrong (John 9:1-2); Insecure in Love results in torment/fear; Rom. 3:17 TLB: they have never known what is to feel secure or enjoy God's blessing
 - Fight and Quarrel for earthly things (James 4:1,2)
 - Constantly looking out for themselves (Matt 6:32) and anxious about them
 - Constantly in the corporate way of thinking throughout the week of what we must to go higher instead of seeing that in the family that there is no competition, in basketball team if someone is good on your team you are happy because they are in your team; in God's presence people's insecurities were constantly being exposed
 - We need to honest instead of putting the things God is showing us under the rug (justifying ourselves)
- What has the enemy done to take us away from the security in God's Love
- Imply things about God's nature through circumstances (Gen 3:5; Job 2:3, 5; Job 19:6)
 - You were a mistake (John 8:41)
 - Misrepresented (John 8:41-44,48)
 - Suffering (John 9:1-2)
 - Imperfect Earthly Fathers (Matthew Luke 11:13)
 - Partiality we've seen in earthly parents (Gen 25:28)
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- How can we be secure in the Father's Love?
- Renewing of our mind (Rom 12:2)
- Rejoices over us (Zep 3:17)
 - Celebrates over us (Luke 15:32)
 - Things about us constantly more than sands of the shore (Ps. 139: 18)
 - Knows us intimately (Ps. 139:3)
 - Is for us and not against us (Rom. 8:31)
 - Not counting our sins (2 Cor. 5:19)
 - Didn't come to condemn us (Rom. 8:34)
 - He Himself Loves us and to the extent He loved Jesus (John 16:27; John 17:23)
- Seeing Jesus who is was secure in the Father's Love
- Herod (Luke 13:32)
 - Pilate (John 19:10,11)
 - Ministry (Wedding feast, going to Jerusalem) (John 2:4, John 7:6, Luke 4:42)
- Our Responsibility in the body of Christ (I Cor. 12:22-26; 1 Cor. 4:15)
- Recognize, encourage the ministry of the hidden brothers and sisters and hide ourselves if our ministry is seen
 - We would allow God to do a work in our life so that they can see that we have a loving Heavenly Father
