Psalm 85: Jesus our Redeemer

85:10 (NASB) "Lovingkindness and truth have met together; Righteousness and peace have kissed each other."

Redeem : the deliverance of persons or property that had been sold for debt: the kinsman-redeemer was responsible for preserving the integrity, life, property, and family name of his close relative or for executing justice upon his murderer. God's complete, sovereign freedom to liberate human beings. "To buy out" especially of purchasing a slave with a view to his freedom. To release on receipt of ransom. To be purchased from the slave market of sin, totally set free, never to be sold again. Deliverance from the guilt of sins.
